We know that you will continue to support CTA down that road with us. The need for CTA in our church and world has never been greater and we have never had a better foundation of staff members, board members, leadership constituencies and general members to carry us forward.

We thank everyone in advance for the gold-colored Timex watch we might receive, although we plan on having less need to know what time it is.
